

Patrick Hendricks is an Advisor on the Foundation Relations team at St. Jude Children's Research Hospital/ALSAC, where he manages a portfolio of foundations that invest in the Hospital's life-saving treatment and research. Previously, he worked in fund development for New York Presbyterian Hospital's \$1 billion capital campaign, as well as The Regional Medical Center at Memphis Foundation.

Patrick had a brief stint in the public sector, overseeing public-private partnerships at the Memphis Mayor's Innovation Delivery Team, funded by Bloomberg Philanthropies. Then he served as Community Engagement Manager for Shelby County Schools, managing external partnerships, district-community relations, and fund development for Tennessee's largest school district.
